Schedule C: Three Phase Service with Demand

Effective: This rate shall become effective April 2011 energy use.

Availability: Available to consumers who require 70 kVa or more of effective transformer capacity, subject to the rules, regulations and policies of the Cooperative. Single-phase motors shall not have a locked rotor current in excess of 200 amperes at 230 volts, and three-phase motors shall not have a locked rotor current in excess of 290 amperes at 230 volts or 145 amperes at 460 volts unless approval is given by this Cooperative for larger locked rotor currents for specific cases. In some instances it may be necessary for the consumer to install current limiting motor starters of an approved type.

Type of Service: Three-phase, 60 cycles at available secondary voltage.

Monthly Rate:

Facility Charge	\$83.00
Demand Charge – November thru April	\$9.10 per kW
Demand Charge – May thru October	\$12.35per kW
Energy Charge	\$0.0632 per kWh

Minimum Monthly Charge: The minimum monthly billing is the facility charge of \$83.00. Where it is necessary to extend or rebuild existing distribution facilities, the monthly facility charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation for the added facilities.

Power Factor Adjustment: The consumer should maintain unity power factor as nearly as practical. Energy charges may be adjusted to correct for average power factors lower than 90%. Such adjustment will be made by increasing the monthly bill 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

Temporary Service: Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges, the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service, less the value of material returned to stock. A deposit in advance may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service including the cost of connection and disconnection.

Power Cost Adjustment: This rate shall be subject to change based on the adjustments to the wholesale power cost or other cost adjustments as determined by People's Cooperative Services.

Terms of Payment: These rates are net. The gross rates are five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current month's bill is not paid by the due date indicated on the bill, the gross rate shall apply.

Taxes: The rates set forth are based on taxes as of April 1, 2011, and the amount of any increase in existing or new taxes allocated to sales hereunder shall be added to the rates as appropriate to be paid by the consumer.
