Schedule CSR: Controllable Seasonal Rate

Effective: This rate shall become effective April 2011 energy use.

Availability: Available for all installations with seasonal energy use requiring between 70 and 300 KVA of transformer capacity. All are subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative and execution of an electric service agreement between the Cooperative and the customer.

Type of Service: Single phase or three phase, 60 cycle at available secondary voltages.

Monthly Rate:

Peak Period Demand Charges: The Peak Period Demand Charges consist of two separate and distinct charges.

- a. The **Monthly Peak Transmission Charge** is the highest metered 15-minute peak demand for energy in the month's billing cycle.
- b. The **Monthly Peak Demand Charge for Months Load Control is Requested** is the highest metered 15 minute peak demand for energy during the time the Cooperative may have requested load control in the month's billing cycle. The winter season is defined as November 1 through April 30. The summer season is defined as May 1 through October 30.

Metering: The Cooperative shall provide electronic metering to accurately meter kilowatt hours (kWh's) and kilowatt (kW) energy use for proper billing under this rate schedule. A digital radio receiver shall also be provided with a set of "dry" contacts, for use by the member, to determine when Load Control is being requested. It shall be the members' responsibility to determine how he wishes to utilize these contacts to facilitate load control to reduce Peak Demand billing. Equipment installed beyond the "dry" contacts shall be furnished, installed and maintained by the member.

Power Factor Adjustment: The consumer should maintain unity power factor as nearly as practical. Energy charges may be adjusted to correct for average power factors lower than 90%. Such adjustment will be made by increasing the monthly bill 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

Minimum Monthly Charge: The minimum monthly billing is the facility charge of \$115.00. Where it is necessary to extend or rebuild existing distribution facilities, the monthly facility charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation for the added facilities.

Power Cost Adjustment: This rate shall be subject to change based on the adjustments to the wholesale power cost or other cost adjustments as determined by People's Cooperative Services.

Terms of Payment: These rates are net. The gross rates are five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current month's bill is not paid by the due date indicated on the bill, the gross rate shall apply.

Taxes: The rates set forth are based on taxes as of April 1, 2011, and the amount of any increase in existing or new taxes allocated to sales hereunder shall be added to the rates as appropriate to be paid by the consumer.
