Schedule G: Security Lighting

Effective: This rate shall become effective April 2011 energy use.

Availability: Available to members of the Cooperative for dusk to dawn security lighting.

Type of Service: Single-phase, 60 Hz, at available secondary voltages.

Monthly Rate:

70 watt H.P.S.	\$ 6.75 per month
100 watt H.P.S.	\$ 8.65 per month
150 watt H.P.S.	\$ 9.70 per month
200 watt H.P.S.	\$10.80 per month
250 watt H.P.S.	\$12.15 per month
400 watt H.P.S.	\$16.65 per month
175 watt Mercury Vapor	\$ 9.70 per month
400 watt Mercury Vapor	\$16.75 per month

Conditions of Service: This rate includes installation, maintenance and electricity with installation on existing pole where 120 volts is available ahead of the consumer's metering. All security lighting fixtures shall be owned, maintained and operated by the Cooperative. Maintenance will be performed only during normal working hours. When a consumer desires to have the light located at a place other than at the Cooperative's transformer or meter pole, the consumer is required to pay the extra cost of material, labor, and overhead expense involved with this relocation.

To help conserve energy, effective November 1, 1992, all newly installed Cooperative all-night security lights shall be high-pressure sodium or lighting with equivalent or better energy efficiency.

All existing, in service, security lights shall be replaced with high pressure sodium or lighting with equivalent or better energy efficiency when replacement is required because of ballast or fixture failure for any reason, including vandalism or other damage.

Terms of Payment: These rates are net. The gross rates are five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current month's bill is not paid by the due date indicated on the bill, the gross rate shall apply.

Taxes: The rates set forth are based on taxes as of April 1, 2011 and the amount of any increase in existing or new taxes allocated to sales hereunder shall be added to the rates as appropriate to be paid by the consumer.
